

SV Judge's Request Form

This form is mandatory to secure an SV Judge. If your event will require more than one SV Judge, please use a separate form for each judge. ALL requests must be in the hands of the SV at least 8 weeks in advance of the event to ensure all paperwork can be authorized. No exceptions can be made if the deadline is not met! This is a WUSV rule. Clubs MUST submit the SV Request form to USCA office at least 12 WEEKS in advance of the event to ensure that the SV deadline is met. (EAF must also be submitted as both forms are necessary for insurance purposes)
