I believe that the SV Office would like to know why this dog has "AKC Limited Registration" with the American Kennel Club (AKC), in order to process the registrations or hd/ed certifications requested of your office by the dog owner.

In America, there are no requirements by the AKC for dogs for entry into breeding, a dog with bad hips or bad elbows can be bred and those puppies can be registered if the breeder of that dog sells it with AKC Full Registration. Being a responsible breeder, I adhere to the SV breeding guidelines for my dogs and because there is no control by AKC on what dog may be used for breeding with AKC, I require all puppies from my breeding kennel to adhere to the SV breeding guidelines as well. Because AKC has no breeding requirements, the above identified dog has AKC limited registration so that this dog cannot have registered puppies from it with the AKC until all SV requirements are met on this dog. The requirements that must be met are as follows:

SV hd/ed certification
Valid Show Rating for angekört
BH
AD
minimum IPG 1 or IPO 1 (with 80 pts protection)
angekört

Once these requirements have been met, there is required paperwork by the AKC for me to sign as the breeder that can allow this dog to be used for breeding. This paperwork requires me to agree to change the dog from AKC Limited Registration to AKC Full Registration and this is the only control that I have as the breeder of this dog to ensure the SV standards are upheld in the breeding of this dog in America.

Please process the above identified dog's registration or hd/ed x-rays for certification as the owner is being responsible and following the SV breeding guidelines per our sales contract.
