There are several options for airport access to the area, close to Morgan Hill:



Destination Event – Make it a VACATION

Morgan Hill may not seem like a tourist destination, but its convenient location makes it an **ideal spot**. A quick drive north will take you to San Jose, the heart of Silicon Valley. A quick jaunt south, and you'll find yourself staring at cliffside seascapes near Carmel, Monterey, Capitola, or Santa Cruz.

While there, you can experience the impressive Monterey Bay Aquarium, Santa Cruz Beach Board Walk, or the quaint shopping and dining experiences in these gorgeous coastal locations. To the west of Morgan Hill is the state's largest park, Henry W. Coe State Park, a popular rural escape amongst Bay Area urbanites.

Bounded by the Santa Cruz Mountains to the west and the Diablo Mountains to the east, hikers and mountain bikers will find numerous trails to explore. One of the most popular destinations for hikers is Henry Coe State Park with over 250 miles of trails, ranging from easy day trips to strenuous backpacking excursions.

In the general area, there are also a number of microbreweries, wineries, Gilroy Outlet Mall and golf courses good for perspective on dusty trail-based forays in the hills; more placid is the 15-mile multi-purpose trail that links Morgan Hill with San Jose, a pleasant way to get between the two once you've had time to track down handmade souvenirs in the quaint shops of historic downtown.


Tracking – Dirt – 15 minutes from stadium

Practice Fields


