Destination Event – Make it a VACATION

Fields will be similar to the conditions shown, but the dirt will be worked prior to the event to ensure consistent and uniform conditions across the board.







Practice Fields


There is one club field within 15 minutes of the stadium that will be available for practice. There are two other club fields that are approximately 30 minutes from the stadium. These fields will be available to all competitors leading up to the event and throughout the event. Blinds, wall, hurdle – all will be available.

Hotels
