Club Experience:

Fox Valley Police & Schutzhund Club has hosted numerous Regional Championships and two Regional Conformation Shows and Breed Surveys. They have offered multiple RH seminars and trials.

Area

Black Creek, Wisconsin is a rural Outagamie County town located west of Green Bay, a popular tourist destination for Green Bay Packer fans. The town itself has only a cheese factory as industry and no other attractions but locally there are many things to see and do in the area. There are several nearby Native American Reservations with museums, stores and restaurants; there is a zoo in Green Bay and many restaurants and shops in both Appleton and Green Bay which are both approximately 20 minutes from the trial location. A short drive will find lakes and outdoor activities and the Newton-Blackmour Trail follows an old railroad grade that stretches 22 miles from New London to the east end of the Oneida Nation, and has access approximately .5 miles from the event location.

Nosework:

All Nosework testing areas are all conveniently located within 30 minutes driving distances. Locations will be confirmed after the bid is accepted and those mentioned here are the result of early scouting.

Area search:

We have access to 10+ acres of Christmas tree farm dedicated for Level B Area Search and an additional 5+ Acres of pine forest dedicated for Level A



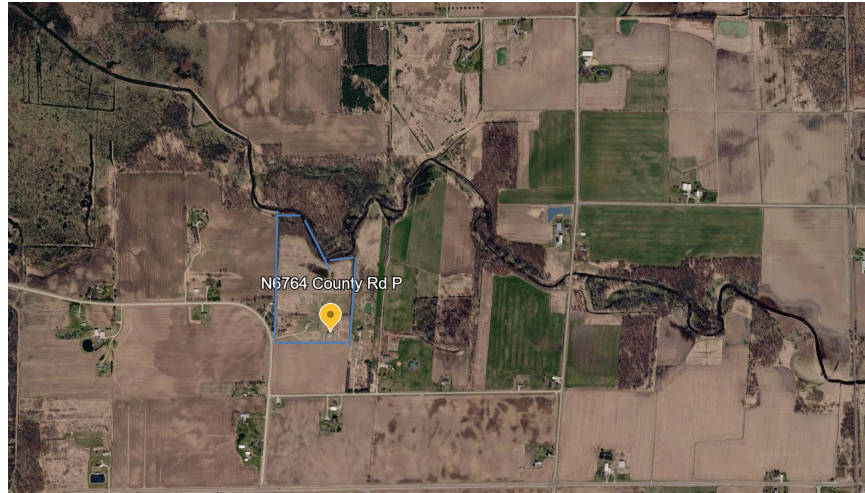
Tracking will be either grass/hay or alfalfa. Depending on planted crop rotation and amount of entries, tracking could potentially be adjacent to the property or very nearby.



Mantrailing locations will be a mixture of rural/suburban and may include exposure to livestock. One potential location is the Outagamie County Fairgrounds.



FVPSC has a 2.2 acre fenced training field where the obedience and dexterity will take place. All appropriate equipment will be provided. There are 39.9 acres of total property that can be available for other portions of the event, as well, and includes wooded and open areas.



There will likely be woodticks at that time of year, but Wisconsin has no fire-ants, poisonous snakes in this area, scorpions, cactus or other natural dangers such as those.
